Policy Strategy and Leadership Course (PSLC)



OVERVIEW

The National Institute's Policy Strategy and Leadership Course (PSLC) which debuted in 2008, is a four week course designed to provide deep conceptual framework for middle-to-top-Ievel policy initiators and implementers who are not only policy input providers of their respective organizations, but on whose skills and resourcefulness most organizations leverage to manage human and material resources for the attainment of corporate goals.

The input of this level of officers is key to policy formulation just as their buy-in is important for policy implementation. Therefore, their analytical skills need to be sharpened to enable them perform effectively as functional and strategic business unit (SBU) managers.

Participants on this Course will be taken through intensive studies in policy formulation, strategy development, resource deployment and effective leadership. This highly interactive course runs quarterly and is made up of three modules - the Policy Module, the Strategy Module and the Leadership and Management Module.

AIM

The Course is aimed at providing middle -to- top level executives with deep understanding of the frameworks for policy formulation and implementation.

Strategy Course for Command Responsibility



OVERVIEW

Command responsibility within the Military, Paramilitary and Intelligence services are strategic leadership positions that are central in facilitating the attainment of field and operational goals. At this strategic level, officers or personnel with command responsibilities are entrusted with legitimate and state-given authority over subordinates, soft/hardware logistics, formations and divisions, in enforcing the implementation of overt and covert tasks, sensitive assignments and operations.

The National Institute for Policy and Strategic Studies (NIPSS), Kuru, in appreciating the extensive experience as well as deft military and tactical skills already possessed by commanders at this level, equally posits that ultimate operational and command success is to a large extent determined by leadership and people management capabilities. The imperative need for competent strategic leadership and skill in manning these national security assets can therefore not be overemphasized.

The Two (2) Week Strategic Course for Command Responsibility (SCCR), was therefore designed by the National Institute, to provide a platform that will facilitate an indepth understanding of related command policy and strategy as well as exercise of required leadership in Military, Para-Military and Intelligence command operations, including Civil-Military relations.

The SCCR is delivered by a rich faculty comprising both serving and retired Resource Persons drawn from the armed forces, as well as highly rated academics of scholarship and repute.

OVERVIEW
